

3. In light of the proposed resolution of this case, the United States does not presently intend to file a complaint in intervention but reserves the right to seek leave to file such a complaint in the event the settlement is breached.

4. The Government requests that Relator's Complaint and First and Second Amended Complaints, this Notice, and the attached proposed Order be unsealed. The United States requests that all other papers on file in this action remain under seal because in discussing the content and extent of the United States' parallel criminal and civil investigation, such papers are provided by law to the Court alone for the sole purpose of evaluating whether the seal and time for making an election to intervene should be extended.

5. The United States respectfully requests that this action remain under seal until May 13, 2013, when a proceeding is scheduled before this Court.


